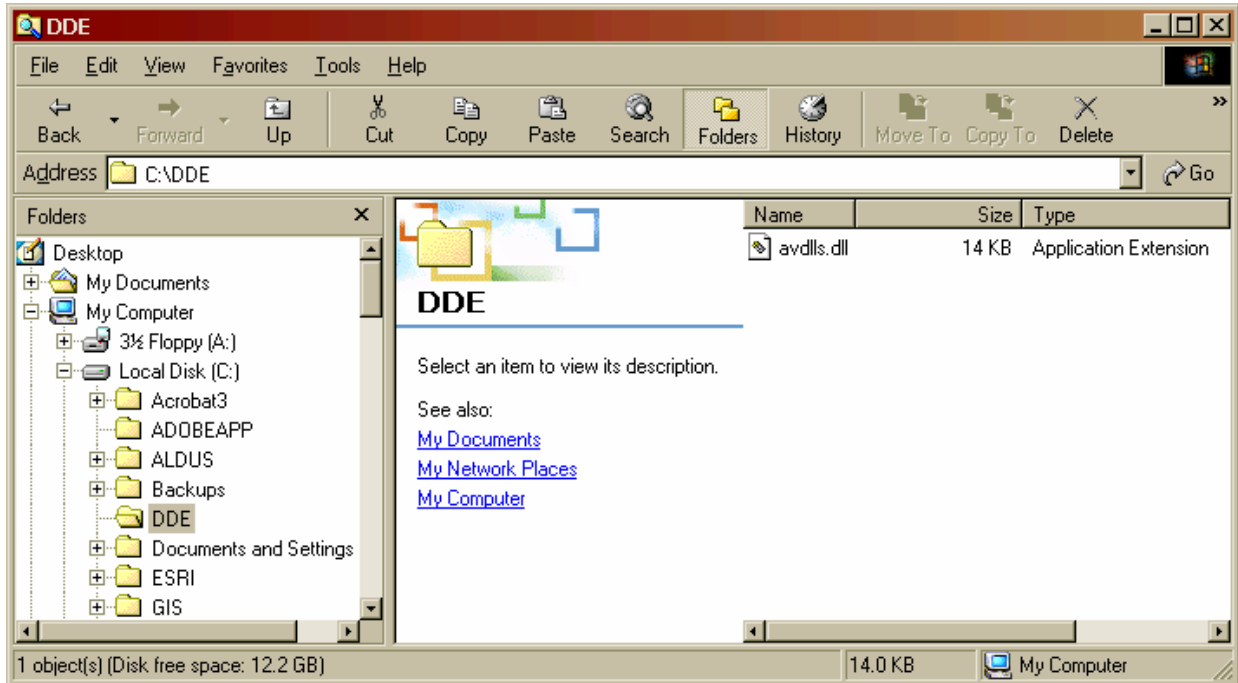


*****There are three files included in this utility (Project File Organizer.zip)*****

1. Readme.txt
2. AVApr.avx (*ArcView extension file*)
3. AVDlls.dll

Installation

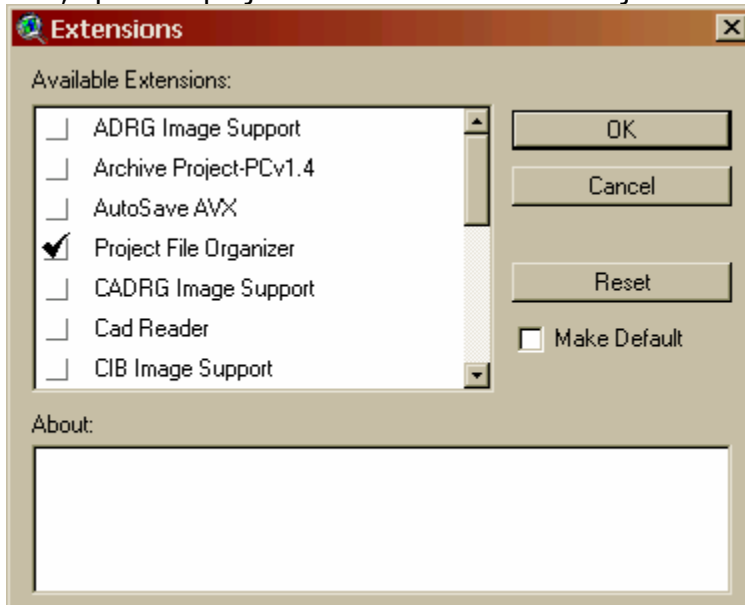
1. Create a new folder named DDE under C:\
2. Place the AVDlls.dll file in the DDE folder



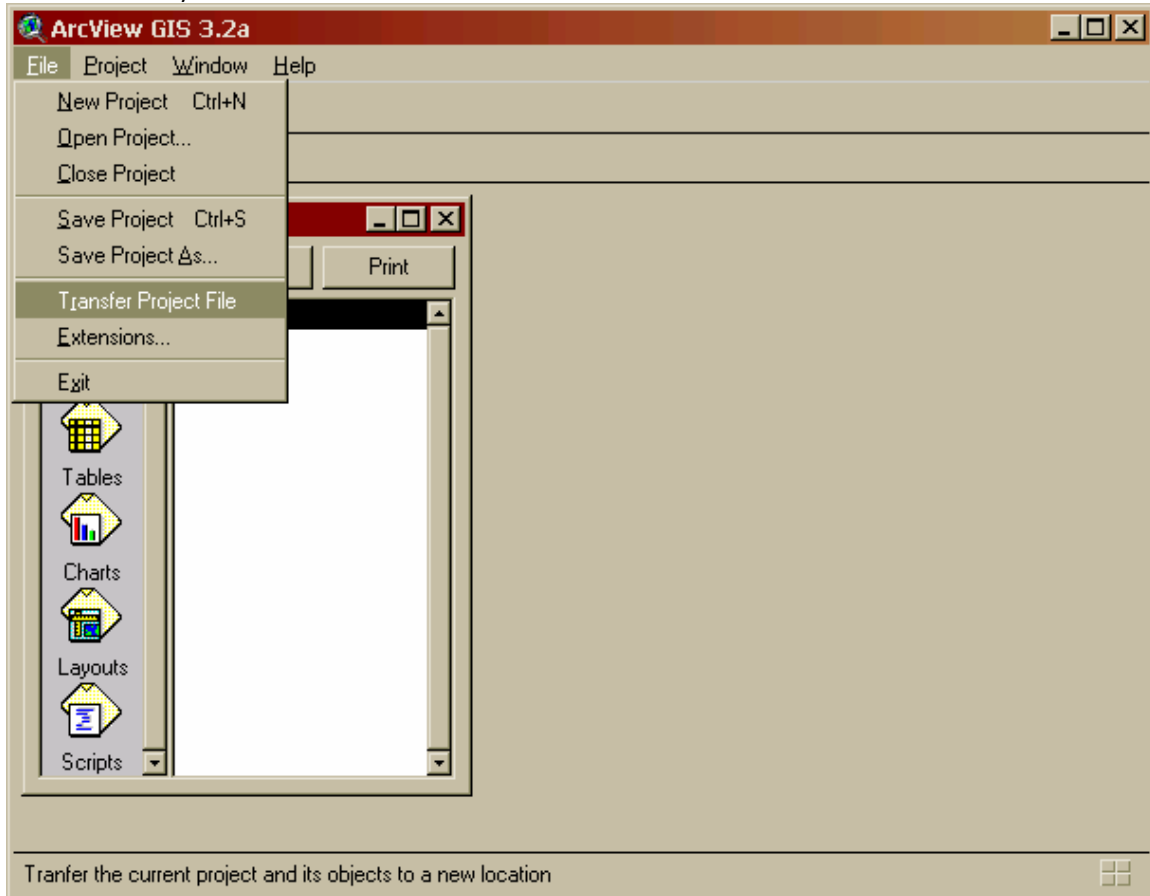
3. Place the AVApr.avx file in ArcView's Ext32 folder.
(C:\ESRI\AV_GIS30\ARCVIEW\EXT32 for those using MS Windows)

Instructions

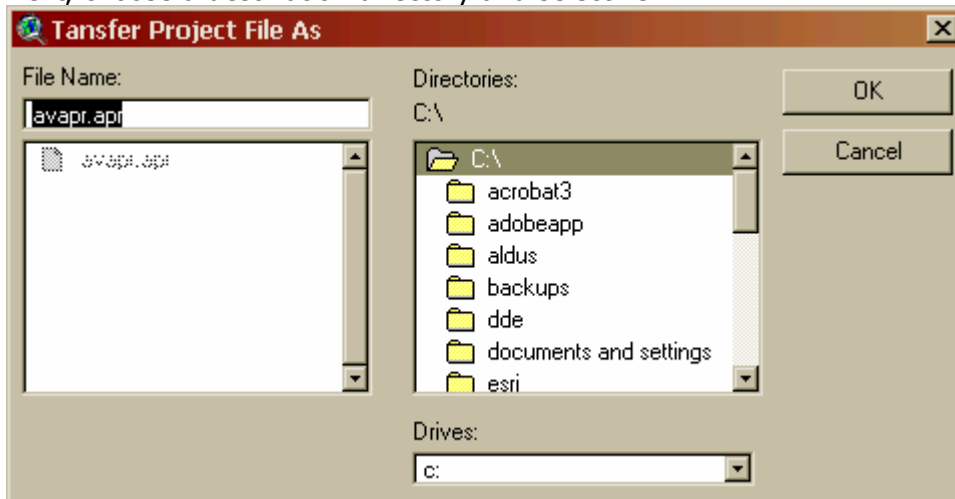
First, open the project file and activate the "Project File Organizer" extension



When you're ready to transfer the file, select the "Transfer Project File" menu item from the File Menu, and define the new file location.



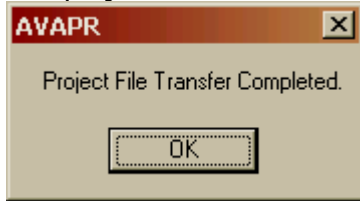
Next, choose a destination directory and select "OK"



****Note**** There is no status bar or any other indicator telling you the project is being transferred. The utility works in the background and although it may seem as though the application has crashed, it is simply working. You'll see a

"Transfer project, please wait" message in the status bar confirming the process has begun.

The project file will then be transferred and give you a confirmation message



To put a project file in a CD, use this extension to copy the project file to the new folder. When completed, copy the entire folder to CD.
